

How can I install a 64bits driver for an USB printer?

To install an USB printer on your **64bits** operating system, you need to connect the USB printer and turn it on, the **"Found New Hardware Wizard"** started, follow the installation instructions and you will arrive to this window **"Cannot Install this Hardware"**.



Or maybe you tried to pass by the **"Add Printer Wizard"**. And each time you restart your computer, the printer is detected as a new hardware.


To fix this problem, connect your printer with the USB cable and turn it on. The **"Found New Hardware Wizard"** starts. Select **"No, not this time"** and click **Next**.




Select **"Install from a list or specific location"** and click **Next**.




Select **“Don’t search, I will choose the driver to install”** and click **Next**.




Select **“Printers”** in the list and click **Next**.




Click **"Have Disk"**.



With the Browse button, **select the driver**. Then click **OK**.



Click **Next**.



Click **Yes**.



Click **“Continue Anyway”**.



Click **Finish**.



The printer is now installed.
